Rules and regulations:

- ◆ Each group is responsible for providing adult leadership for all youth activities and provide competent life guards for all water activities.
- ◆ A certified EMT contact may be required, per ODHS regulations.
- ◆ Day use insurance may be required
- ◆ Fires may be built only in fireplaces and/or designated areas, as seasonally permitted.
- ◆ Smoking is allowed outside, only in designated areas, and ten feet from all building entrances and exits.
- ◆ Firearms and explosives are strictly prohibited on camp property.
- ◆ No pets are allowed on camp property.
- ◆ Please drive posted speed limits.
- ◆ Parking is allowed only in designated areas.
- ◆ Please observe our quiet hours between dusk and dawn.
- ◆ Please stay on walking paths only.
- ◆ No food or drink allowed in dormitories.
- ◆ Please do not pick wildflowers, fern, or fauna.
- ◆ Please place litter and trash in garbage receptacles.
- ◆ Please do not sit or stand on wood railing.
- ◆ Only camp staff is allowed in the kitchen area per ODHS regulations.

The management of Camp Cascade strive to protect the wildlife and natural habitat surrounding the campgrounds and would ask all guests to enjoy your stay with us with these thoughts in mind. Any group or individual who fails to comply with camp rules or becomes involved in any illegal activities while at Camp Cascade may be asked to leave and may be subject to a \$50.00 fine per incident. If your group has any special facility needs, please notify camp management as early as possible.
